Freedom of Information request: FOI.061.25

I am writing in response to the Freedom of Information request you submitted to this office and dated 8 March 2025, in which you requested the following:

- **A Certified copy of the exemption instrument/certificate/notice/document that exempts government departments and government corporations and government funded corporations from complying with the Bills of Exchange Act 1882**
- **A list of those government departments and government corporations and government funded corporations and any other corporations that are exempt from the Bills of Exchange Act 1882**

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 FOIA gives individuals and organisations the right of access to all types of recorded information held, at the time the request is received, by public authorities such as the Attorney General's Office (AGO).

Section 1 of the FOIA places two duties on public authorities. Unless exemptions apply, the first duty (contained in section 1(1)(a)) is to confirm or deny whether the information specified in a request is held. If confirmed, the second duty (contained in section 1(1)(b)) is, unless one or more of the exemptions contained in Part II of the FOI Act apply, to disclose the information that has been confirmed as being held.

I have now been able to consider your request and can confirm that we do not hold any information within the scope of your request.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date of receipt of the response to your original letter and should be addressed to correspondence@attorneygeneral.gov.uk or to the above address.

Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.

If you are not content with the outcome of the internal review, you have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision. The Information Commissioner can be contacted
